MISSION, OBJECTIVES AND PRIORITIES OF THE UNIVERSITY INTERNATIONALIZATION

The internationalization strategy of Belarusian State University of Informatics and Radioelectronics (BSUIR) developed under the project No. 544125-TEMPUS-1-2013-1-AM-TEMPUS-SMGR "Promoting Internationalization of HEIs in Eastern Neighbourhood Countries through Cultural and Structural Adaptations" (further referred to as the project "PICASA") of the European Union program TEMPUS IV.

This strategy is included in BSUIR Development Program for the period of 2016-2020 adopted by the decision of the University Council (Minutes No. 4 as of 24.12.2015) and approved by the Rector's order No. 381 as of 31.12.2015.

The internationalization strategy of Belarusian State University of Informatics and Radioelectronics is designed to facilitate the implementation of one of the major challenges facing the University in 2016-2020 that is the international cooperation development.

The University's mission as the national leader in the branch is to carry out educational and research activities aimed at training specialists with specialized secondary and higher education and postgraduates capable of perceiving, generating and implementing innovative ideas and creating competitive high-tech products in computer science and electronics.

BSUIR Development Priorities:

- 1. in the field of internationalization of education:
- system-wide integration of the EHEA instruments into the University's study process;
- organization and system-wide enlargement of specialties, unification of qualifications, termination of obsolete specialities, areas of training and specializations of higher education in line with the new National Index 011-2016 "Specialties and Qualifications" which is harmonized with the requirements of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED 2013) to be integrated with the EHEA taking into account the requirements and needs of the real economy;
 - 2. in the field of internationalization of research:
- a larger number of professors, doctoral, PhD and Master students, as well as first degree students involved in scientific research and wider participation in competitions of scientific projects carried out by national and foreign foundations and organizations;
- improved scientometric indicators of R&D activities via increased number of publications in top-ranking scientific journals with high impact factor.
 - 3. in the field of international cooperation development:
 - increased competitiveness of graduates on the international labor market;
 - raised visibility of the university on the international market;
 - improved internationalization of the university in education and research;
 - enhanced export of educational services and R&D products and services;
 - advanced system of international cooperation management of the University.
