

A tenure or a career promotion system in place that recognizes interdisciplinary science research in BSUIR

The university's leadership regularly rewards researchers conducting interdisciplinary research with Certificates of Honor, Diplomas, and letters of gratitude from the university, and also nominates them for awards from state bodies of the Republic of Belarus. In 2024, the Center's scientific director and head of the industry laboratory was awarded a Certificate of Honor from the State Committee for Science and Technology of the Republic of Belarus.

The University has adopted the Regulation on Stimulating Publication Activity №11 of April 29, 2020. The Regulation is aimed at improving the scientific level of publications (in particular, in interdisciplinary areas), increasing their number in indexed domestic and foreign publications (Screenshot 1). According to the Regulation BSUIR give employees (who are authors of publications, in particular, on interdisciplinary research, in indexed domestic and foreign journals) cash bonus annually.
